# GENERAL ORDER NUMBER 5 FEBRUARY 2022

1. <u>Commander's Remarks:</u> I would like to thank Supreme Sr. Vice Commander, Dwight Hora, for having the displeasure of gracing us at our Grand Scratch this Past month. The Scratch was well attended and provided insight into the Grand has forthcoming. The Supreme Sr. Vice recognized Cootie Joanne Smith for the tireless work she has done since joining Pup Tent 13 earlier this year.

We are coming into the homestretch for the year; yet we still have a few steps to take before we can close out the year. Every Pup Tent is on the verge of making 100% in membership (just need to get those reports submitted). Yes, those First and Second-Degree Cooties count, and will receive a hat from the Grand once their transmittal is submitted to the Grand.

The biggest hurdle that Pup Tents are facing is Hospital Reports, yes it has been a rough couple of years for hospital reports, but Supreme has relaxed the criteria to help make up for this. If you call and check up on a veteran or if you mail a letter to a veteran, you can count it as a Hospital Report. If you drive a veteran to a hospital appointment, report it. If you attended a veteran's funeral or memorial service, report it. Attached is a form that I hope will help Cooties with their reports; just fill out and submit to your Pup Tent Hospital Chair.

Our recruiting efforts are paying dividends on both the VFW and Cootie side. The Grand has recruited 318 members for the VFW and on the Cootie side we have 18 new members to the Grand. Every one of those Cooties are actively engaged within their Pup Tents.

- 2. <u>Elections:</u> Installation of shavetails must be completed prior to March 31<sup>st</sup>. Start looking for nominations, and appointments, to fulfill the requirement.
- 3. <u>Ham It Up:</u> The Ham It Up program is up and running! Money raised through the program is earmarked for the VFW National Home. Please consider signing up and doing your part to support the National Home. Please see attached form to sign-up.
- 4. **Grand Email List:** Seam Squirrels, CCDB's, Hungry Cooties, and Cooties in the Grand should send an email to grandofvirginia+subscribe@groups.io to subscribe for communications from the Grand.
- 5. **Grand Recruiting Competition:** The Supreme is looking to recognize those Grands that are "refilling our VFW pond." If you are out there recruiting and not seeing your name

- 10. <u>Blood Reports:</u> Blood Reports should be submitted to <a href="http://vampire.puptent1.org/">http://vampire.puptent1.org/</a> in order for the Supreme to recognize your effort. Questions or pleas for assistance may be directed to the Supreme Vampire via the above page.

- 11. <u>Pup Tent Inspections:</u> Grand is 100% inspected; thank you all for working to complete your Pup Tent Inspections.
- 12. <u>Membership Dues:</u> Due's payment, with appropriate Transmittal Forms, need to be sent directly to Grand Quartermaster Marcia Eggers, <u>grandqm@vfwva.org</u>, in a most timely and expedient manner.

#### **CREDIT ALLOWANCE**

- 1. Transportation Credit: \$0.14 per mile per Cootie to and from hospitals domiciles, nursing homes, etc., where sick veterans are visited, excluding family members. Actual cost, instead of mileage, is used if other than POV's are used.
- 2. Tolls: Report actual cost under "mileage" as required.
- **3.** *Hours:* All volunteer visitation, preparation hours, and travel time credited at \$22.55 per hour per Cootie. Travel time limited to actual hours expended.
- **4.** *Veteran's Funeral Credit*: Credit each Cootie at **\$22.55** per hour, for the number of hours it may require and \$0.14 per mile round trip for attendance at any veteran's funeral. (If more than one Cootie rides in a vehicle, only the driver of the vehicle gets the mileage credit.) Remember that deceased veterans deserve an Honor Guard.
- **5.** Warrior Call Credit: Calling veterans to check on welfare, comradeship, and keeping the lines of communication open. Record call time per veteran called in hours block.
- **6.** Mail/Correspondence Credit: **Pen Pal letters, One-way cards or One-way letters** get 0.2 (twelve minutes) per letter or card with materials/postage cost of \$4.00 listed as a "Gift".
- 7. Gifts: Actual retail cost of the item. By definition, "gifts" include anything bought by the MOC for use or appreciation by the hospitalized veteran. For homemade or home-grown items, the cost is estimated, but never more than retail. Used items are reported at no more than one half their actual costs, keeping in mind the useful life of the item. Operation UP-LINK Calling card donations are credited under this section of the hospital report form.
- **8.** *Clothing Credit:* Itemize all clothing on the Hospital Chairperson's report form or attach to the report an itemized consolidated sheet.
- 9. Veteran's Transportation: No credit allowed for transportation of other veterans. These activities are reported to the VFW Post Community Activities Chairperson.
- **10**. *Hospital Equipment:* Hospital equipment loaned to individuals is reported to your VFW Post Hospital Program.
- 11. *Blood Donations:* Report all blood donations to your Pup Tent Blood Chairperson. Refer all questions pertaining to blood collections to the Supreme Blood Program Chairman listed elsewhere in this Program Book.
