Pup Tent Inspections: Inspections will commence this month. Grand Inspectors will be in touch with their respective area Pup Tents to schedule the inspections. Seam Squirrels, CCDBs, and Hospital Chairmen are requested to be in attendance for the inspection. Make sure to have everything inspectable ready to go.

Pup Tent Audits: Quarterly Audits are required to be completed and submitted to Grand Quartermaster Marcia Eggers no later than (NLT) 30 days after the end of each calendar quarter. Reports should be emailed to grandqm@vfwva.org.

Pup Tent Bonds: per the 2022 update Supreme Bylaws – Pup Tent CCDB's shall obtain sufficient security bond in the sum equal to the amount of liquid assets for which they are accountable. Pup Tents with total liquid assets of \$5,000.00 or more shall require a bond. Pup Tents with liquid assets less than \$5,000.00, may bond or not bond as determined by the Pup Tent. This is an inspectable item so make sure you have this situated.

Membership: The 2022-2023 Membership Cards have gone out in June 2022. Now is the time to start contacting the annual members in your Pup Tent and get them renewed. Please don't wait thinking you'll see them in December 2022 to get them renewed for 2023!

This revised form will allow the Supreme Headquarters to better track information for the Supreme Commander.
