STANDING MOTIONS FOR 2021-2022

1. Motion for the Pup Tent to allocate an amount not to exceed \$250.00 to provide candy for the Dale City 4th of July Parade.

3. Motion for the Pup Tent C.C.D.B. to allocate funds in the amount outlined by Supreme for the Pup Tent Bond. The bond amount will be \$1,000.00 greater than the year-end balance of the C.C.D. B's Pup Tent bank statement.
4. Motion for the Pup Tent to allocate an amount not to exceed \$250.00 for the post 1503 Food Basket program.
5. Motion for the Pup Tent to allocate an amount not to exceed \$300.00 for the Annual Pup Tent Christmas Dinner. The amount paid is a 50% cost shared with the MOC Auxiliary to Pup Tent 14.
6. Motion for the Pup Tent to allocate an amount not to exceed \$300.00 for the Pup Tent Installation Dinner. The amount paid is a 50% cost shared with the MOC Auxiliary to Pup Tent 14.
7. Motion for the Pup Tent to allocate an amount \$1.00 per member to Supreme requirements for the National Home Program.
8. Motion for the Pup Tent to allocate an amount \$1.00 per member to Supreme requirements for the Supreme Commanders Special Project.

9. Motion for the Pup Tent to Donate \$100.00 to VFW Post 1503 Golf Tournament.

10. Motion for the Pup Tent to split 50/50 all proceeds raised during fund raiser with the MOC Auxiliary to Pup Tent 14.
